FJWC Designated Philanthropies

Altharetta Yeargin Art Museum (AYAM), Bayou Blessings in a Backpack, CanCare, Family Point Resources (FPR), HERO, JDRF, Literacy Advance, Houston Symphony & Ronald McDonald House

You may only earn service hours by volunteering for an FJWC Designated Charity OR at an FJWC Official Service Opportunity (e.g. in the past, we have supported the Stratford Big Day and Garage Sale for a limit of 3 hours). FJWC Hours should be counted ONLY toward FJWC – and not double dipped with another service organization (NCL, NHS, Girl Scouts, etc). A member may earn up to a MAXIMUM of 3 service hours yearly for volunteering at a (non-FJWC) philanthropy of her choice.

Philanthropic Service Requirements

Actives:	30 service hours
Professionals:	15 service hours
Provisionals:	6 introductory visits to at least 6 of 9 FJWC Philanthropies
High School Students:	12 service hours or 4 service projects (3 hours or longer)

Monetary Donations: Members may earn up to a maximum of 9 service hours per year by donating money or gift cards at a FJWC Philanthropy Donation Drive (at a rate of \$25 = 3 service hours). Members must earn all other service hours by volunteering at an FJWC philanthropy.

To get credit for FJWC hours, members and students MUST log in all service hours, monetary donations, FJWC leadership hours and Provisional visits at: www.fjwc.org. Deadline is May 1st.

General Meeting Requirements

Actives and Provisionals:	Attend at least 6 General Meetings. Attendance is recorded.
Professionals:	Encouraged to attend General Meetings if possible.

Committee Requirements

Actives, Professionals and Provisionals actively serve on BOTH an Auction Committee AND a Standing Committee. Committee Members earn no volunteer service hours. Committees Members are assigned by the Executive Board by expressed interest indicated on the Membership Form.

Membership Financial Requirements

Actives, Professionals and Provisionals are responsible for paying annual membership fees (for members and students), auction ticket cost (for 4 tickets) and donation (\$150 or 3 \$50 items).
